Mrs. Tafoya agreed and added her thanks to the Superintendent for bringing it forward as a community wide effort. ● The committee asked several questions and agreed that the presentation was very informative.

He shared the Safety Drill Schedule and went over examples of what the drills looked like during Red Ribbon week. ● The committee suggested parents being involved in Red Ribbon week. Dr. Fulenwider did add that the school websites will include Red Ribbon Week information going forward. The committee had concerns on how parents are being informed if a campus should be placed on a lockdown for any type of reason. Dr. Fulenwider shared that parents are informed through Parent Square within a matter of minutes. Officer Pratt also shared that parents should always wait for an all clear before approaching a school should they be on a lockdown. Dr. Fulendwider shared some great examples of all clear procedures for classrooms that were followed recently at Washington.
