<p>D. Discussion Items – Dr. Tim Fulenwider</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Dr. Tim Fulenwider presented the revised Rubric. It was agreed that Dr. Fulenwider would change the wording on Expectation #3, regarding “Campus grounds are inviting and well groomed”. The revision will be under the Highly Effective Column, and will now read, “<u>All</u> lines of sight are unobstructed”. ❖ The Committee discussed the new Safety portion of the Rubric. Discussion included possible software (i.e. RAPTOR) that will produce name badges and checks for visitors. Dr. Fulenwider discussed reviewing a suggested list of supplies for schools at the next meeting. It was suggested that each classroom have a toileting kit. It was suggested that parents should be able to have safety training thru the Parent Centers. Communications with parents regarding safety concerns was discussed including the use of text and other technology. ❖ Dr. Fulenwider asked the committee if any other items need to be added to the Rubric. It was recommended that we add a portion to the Rubric on Absenteeism. The committee agreed that having some type of display at each site showing the attendance goals would be a good idea to engage parents is setting attendance goals with their students. ❖ It was recommended that we make it very clear to teachers and staff before visiting the sites that the rubric is not an evaluation tool; instead, it is a per site observation. ❖ Dr. Fulenwider shared a presentation with the committee laying out the Committee’s recommendations to the Superintendent.
