Jefferson's ELAC is now accepting nominations for parent members on the English Learner Advisory Committee. This is a two-year term: September 2023 - May 2024, and: September 2024 -May 2025.


The ELAC serves English Learner students and the school by:

- Advising the principal and staff in the development of a site plan for English learners and submitting the plan to the School Site Council for consideration of inclusion in the School Plan for Student Achievement.
- Assisting in the development of the schoolwide needs assessment.
- Ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
- Each ELAC shall have the opportunity to elect at least one member to the District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC). Districts with 31 or more ELACs may use a system of proportional or regional representation.

Parent members of the ELAC are expected to:

- attend all 4 meetings
- learn about the SPSA through trainings and information shared at ELAC meetings;
- represent EL parents in the neighborhood and community; and
- actively participate in ELAC responsibilities
