## SCHOOL BUS DRIVER CLASSROOM TRAINING

Classroom training is a one (1) week unpaid course provided by Bakersfield City School District. It's Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

- o Visit <u>applitrack.com/bakersfield/onlineapp</u> to view the next classroom training dates.
- Submit your application and attach a DMV Record printout (K4) (dated within 30 days). Online printouts are accepted.

- You will receive a T-01 card after successfully completing the classroom instruction hours. Must attend all days.

## SCHOOL BUS DRIVER TRAINEE

An application for School Bus Driver Trainee must be submitted along with all the documents listed below in order to be eligible to become sponsored for behind the wheel training.

- Requirements for trainee:
  - T-O1 Card (Received aftercompletion of classroom training)
  - DMV Record Printout (K4) (dated within 30 days)
  - o Class B permit
    - with Passenger Endorsement
    - ❖ with Air Brakes
  - Medical Examination Report & Certificate
  - o Resume (10 year work history)

Sponsorship requires School Bus Driver Applicant/Trainee instruction fee agreement.

  - DMV Record Printout (dated within 30 days)
  - o Current T-O1 Card
  - o Resume (10 year work history)
